The world is in uncharted waters.

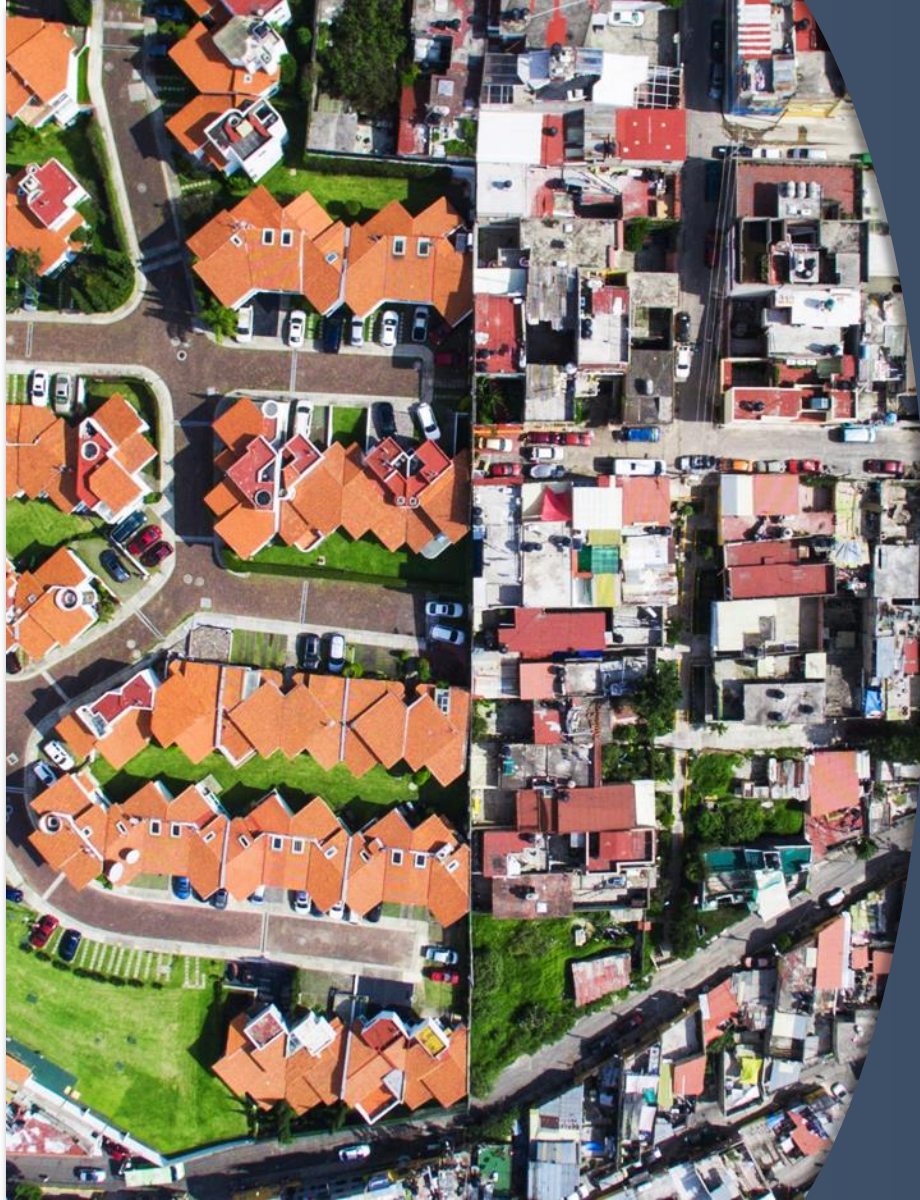
Many of the lessons, models and ideologies that businesses and governments once held dear are going to have to change

Purpose can be drawn not just from work, but also from family, community and society.

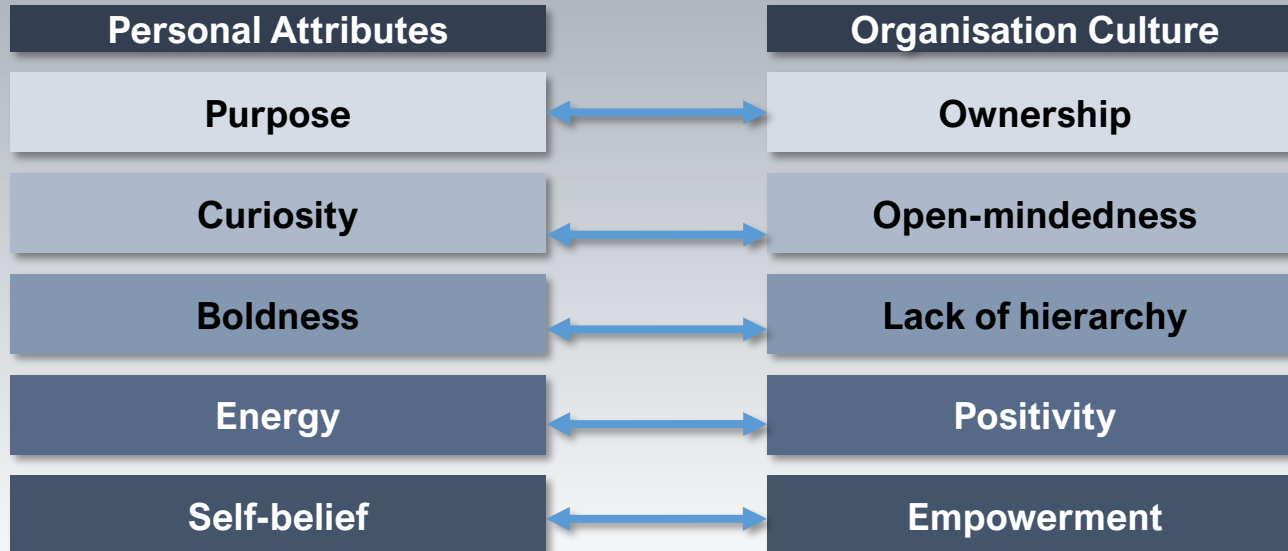
Resetting leadership starts by first defining purpose

But how?

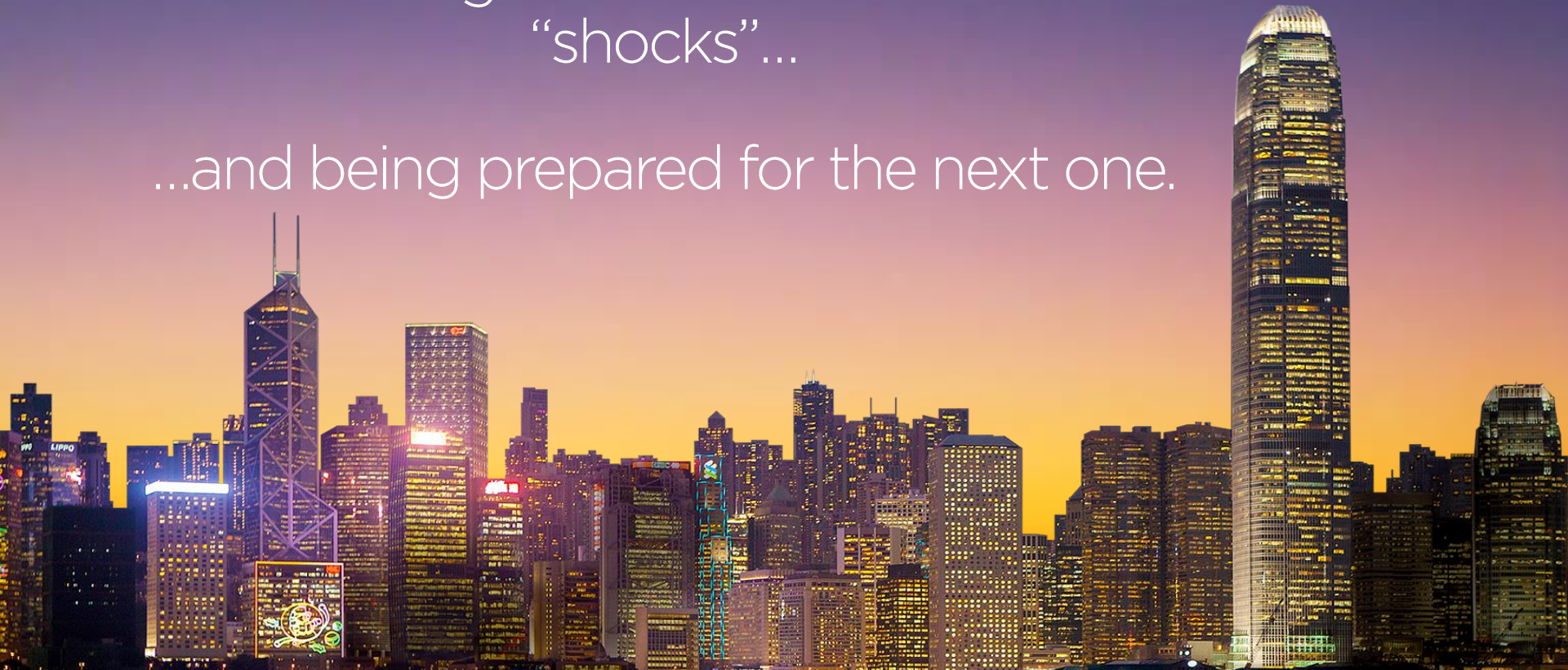
An organisation with the right leadership and culture for empowering potential can achieve far more than it imagined possible.
